## ***Monte Vista Water District Poster Contest Winners Recognized in Regional Competition***

**MONTCLAIR, CA . . . . .** Hannah T. Guthrie and Logan T. Guthrie, winners of Monte Vista Water District's poster contest, were recognized again for their award-winning artwork by Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, sponsor of the annual "Water is Life" regional student art contest. The siblings' posters were among 36 selected out of several hundred entries, representing artwork from grades Kindergarten through 12, submitted by water agencies in MWD's six-county service area.

Hannah, a sixth grade student at Monte Vista Elementary, placed first in the Grades 4-6 division for Monte Vista Water District's local poster contest, while Logan, a second grader, also received first in the Grades K-3 division. The district then sent eight winning posters to MWD for judging in the regional contest.

"What an accomplishment for these two siblings," said Board Vice President Phillip Erwin. "We are so proud of Hannah and Logan not only for their winning artwork, but for their ability to creatively express the importance of water. Their posters made a strong impression on the district's judging committee and at the regional level."

The 36 award-winning posters are featured in a 2019 calendar published by MWD, which was unveiled at a special ceremony on Dec. 4 at their headquarters in Los Angeles.

At the awards ceremony, the student artists were recognized for depicting conservation concepts through art. Students, family members, teachers, principals and water agency representatives enjoyed displays of the framed posters and attended a ceremony where each student received an award certificate, an art kit, and a tote bag full of calendars. The art exhibit will be on display at MWD's headquarters until early January, after which it will begin a six-month tour at various water agencies.
