Monte Vista Water District Warns Residents of Local Incidents

Customers cautioned of strangers posing as District employees

MONTCLAIR, CA Monte Vista Water District is encouraging residents to be cautious and confirm workers' identification before letting them inside their homes. The District has received reports of two local incidents where a person attempted to gain entrance to a District customer's home by falsely claiming to be a water agency employee.

It is very unusual for District staff to ever need to enter a person's home. The Water District urges residents to check identification for those claiming to be from a water or local utility agency. District field service staff carry photo identification badges, wear blue or gray uniforms, and drive vehicles—all with the District's logo prominently displayed.

If a person claiming to be a District or water agency representative cannot show an identification badge, residents should not let that person in their home. If in doubt of any such situation, residents should close and lock their door and immediately report the incident to law enforcement.
