**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE MONTE VISTA WATER DISTRICT,  
COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
ADOPTING THE MONTE VISTA WATER DISTRICT'S  
2020 URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN  
AND WATER SHORTAGE CONTINGENCY PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the State of California (State) classifies Monte Vista Water District (District) as an urban water supplier because it serves more than 3,000 customers (i.e. individual metered accounts) and it supplies more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually to its customers for municipal purposes. The State requires every urban water supplier to prepare and adopt an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP), including the Water Shortage Contingency Plan; and periodically update the UWMP at least once every five years, in years ending in six and one; and

**WHEREAS**, The Urban Water Management Plan provides urban water suppliers (including the District) with a reliable management action plan for long-term resource planning to ensure adequate water supplies are available to meet existing and future water supply needs. In addition, the 2020 UWMP incorporates water supply reliability determinations resulting from potential prolonged drought, regulatory revisions, and/or changing climatic conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP), including the Water Shortage Contingency Plan shall be periodically reviewed at least once every five years, and that the District shall make any amendments or changes to its plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's most recent 2015 UWMP was submitted to, and approved by, the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) in 2016. Urban water suppliers (including the District) are required to complete and submit their 2020 UWMPs to DWR by July 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the current requirements for preparing a UWMP are included in California Water Code (CWC) Sections 10608 through 10657. The District is required to hold a public hearing prior to adoption of the UWMP, to provide public notice of such a hearing two weeks in advance of the hearing in the local newspaper, and to make the UWMP available for public inspection prior to its adoption; and

**WHEREAS**, the District is required to notify any city or county within which it delivers water that the agency's UWMP is being reviewed. Finally, the District is required to encourage active involvement of diverse social, cultural, and economic elements of the population within the service area prior to and during the preparation of the UWMP; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's 2020 UWMP has been prepared consistent with the CWC and the recommended organization provided in DWR's "Urban Water Management Plan Guidebook 2020" (March 2021). On May 10, 2021, the District provided notice to the cities of Montclair, Chino, and Chino Hills, to San Bernardino County, and to nine local community stakeholder organizations that the District's UWMP was being updated; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has also communicated with neighboring cities and local water agencies concerning the District's progress in updating its UWMP; and

**WHEREAS**, the Urban Water Management Plan must be adopted by July 1, 2021, after public review and hearing, and filed with the California Department of Water Resources within thirty days of adoption; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has therefore prepared and circulated for public review a draft 2020 Urban Water Management Plan and Water Shortage Contingency Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, a properly noticed public hearing regarding said Urban Water Management Plan, including the Water Shortage Contingency Plan, was held by the Board of Directors on June 23, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the District did prepare and shall file the said Urban Water Management Plan with the California Department of Water Resources (DWR).

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Directors of the Monte Vista Water District does hereby, by this resolution, authorize the adoption of its 2020 Urban Water Management Plan and Water Shortage Contingency Plan and orders the filing of the plan with the California Department of Water Resources.
